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



Our History



Student & Parent Policies

Code of Conduct

The only drama we indulge in is the kind we produce on the stage! In order to provide a positive environment for everyone involved with Count Me In, we have a strict NO DRAMA policy.

There is to be no slandering or rumor spreading of any nature to occur about students, parents or instructors. If an issue arises, feel free to address it with the business manager or owner of the studio in a calm and civil manner. We are always open to a discussion.

Please refrain from discussions involving politics, religion, or profanity on Count Me In property. There is a time and place for such talk, and it is not around impressionable young ears. A good rule of thumb is that if an argument or debate can spark from what one is about to say, it is better kept to one's self.

Treat everyone with kindness and respect. We are here to better ourselves not to tear others down.





Studio Communications

Email

We are a PAPERLESS studio, and EMAIL is our main method of communication with parents and students. PLEASE CHECK YOUR EMAILS FOR INFORMATION FROM CMI EVERY MONTH!!! It is the responsibility of the parent/legal guardian to ensure that a valid email address is on file with the studio at all times, and that our studio email and Studio Director program email addresses are allowed through your emails firewalls and junk mail filters.

No late fees will be waived, nor will any other exceptions to rules, events or other studio information be “lacking in communication” due to a parent not receiving or reading an email. CMI uses email tracking programs to ensure we are notified when an email is bounced, received, read and ignored, as most companies do.

Studio Communications

BAND Ap

We use an ap called BAND (which can be downloaded onto most any cell phone or smart device) for EVERY INDIVIDUAL CLASS in the 8 Month Season.

During the first couple weeks of classes you will receive an email invite with a link to join the Private Band Group for Each Class your student is enrolled in at that time. This ap is used to post the class reminders, music, practice videos and more throughout the season.

This ap also allows you to directly message the class instructor with any questions you may have about that specific class. PLEASE USE THE PRIVATE CHAT FEATURE IN THE CLASS GROUP when reaching out to the instructor with questions. Please allow 24-48 hours (M-F) for them to respond as well.

The Band Ap will also serve as a reference for parents as we upload our handbook, calendar, event reminders and more.

Students are encouraged to use the ap to practice at home. REMEMBER....if they record and post a video of them practicing in their classes Band Group, they can earn GOLD TICKETS - which enters them in for a prize drawing several times each season.



Cell Phone & Social Media Policies

Cell phones are not to be brought into the classroom by any students. They are a distraction that is better left in a dance bag in the lounges or lockers.

Students or Parents engaging in any type of social media platform are prohibited from posting any content that is malicious towards students, instructors, or the Count Me In facility.

Anyone caught engaging in cyberbullying will be asked to leave the studio, dropped from any programs they are currently enrolled with no refunds or credits.

Sharing your love for the studio and our programs on social media is appreciated and we love to see you tag us on your posts. However, remember that you are representing our studio and programs and therefore we ask that you refrain from posting any photos or comments of a questionable nature, with profanity or content inappropriate for children and families.

Class Dress Code

ALL Class descriptions and their specific dress codes can be found on our website - so please check ONLINE for details .

We HIGHLY SUGGEST every student bring a DANCE BAG with them to class each week that has:

PLENTY OF HAIR TIES
HAIR BRUSH
EXTRA DANCEWEAR
DANCE SHOES (& SOCKS FOR TAPPERS)
WATER BOTTLE



Dance Attire/Clothing

Dance classes require that the instructor be able to see the lines of the students body as it moves so that they can give corrections on proper body placement and alignment. Therefore, every class requires students to wear dance wear such as leotards, unitards, or other FORM FITTING sports attire.



Dance Shoes

ALL styles of dance require a specific style and color of shoe to be purchased and worn throughout the ENTIRE DANCE SEASON as well as at the Recital, EXCEPT for Acro classes. Acro students tumble in bare feet and do not need shoes. EVERY OTHER CLASS requires shoes, and we ask them you purchase them within the first 2 weeks of class so your student is prepared to learn each week in their proper attire.



Hair & Nails

Hair should be pulled back and away from the face for ALL classes and styles (NO EXCEPTIONS). IF your student DOES NOT have a hair tie they will be sent to the store to purchase one for 50 cents and that fee will be added to your account. Long nails are never a good idea in dance classes, especially acro, where a lot of floor work is done with the hands.



Jewelry

While wearing a pair of post or short earrings is fine, we highly suggest no bulky or dangling earrings to prevent injury. No bracelets, necklaces or rings should be worn into class either. Please leave those items in your dance bag.

Tuition, Fees & Discounts

Annual Registration Fee

IMPORTANT NOTE REGARDING THE REGISTRATION PROCESS...
A ONE TIME Annual Registration Fee is required to be paid
AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION
to hold your spot(s) in class(es).

Anyone who registers for a class
and does not pay the registration fee within 48 hours,
will be dropped from the class to allow another student to take the spot.

Annual One Time Registration Fee applies to the 8 month and 3 month seasons only and does not apply to summer session or workshops:

\$40 per student
\$60 per siblings
\$75 per family (3+ students)

NOTE: This fee is non-refundable
and is due upon registration to hold class spots.

OR simply use our flat rate monthly payment plan and pay the "per month" amount listed by the 1st of each month.

*All fees are charged on a flat monthly rate basis, regardless of how many weeks are in that month, or how many classes your student attends.

In addition to the monthly class tuition fees, there is a monthly performance fee charged to ALL classes (EXCEPT those labeled as TECH classes) of \$24 per month.

This fee covers costs for performing in the annual recital, and includes the cost of all items detailed below:

- Costume & Tights
- Accessories and/or Props
- Measurements Taken In House (by our onsite seamstresses)
- Ordering, shipping, receiving, organizing, returns and replacements
- Fittings & Alterations Done In House (by our onsite seamstresses)
- Hanging, steaming, pressing, starching, etc Done In House (by our staff)
- Each costume comes with an instruction sheet for hair style, where to put accessories, etc included with the costume and we provide video tutorials for both hair styles and suggested stage makeup application
- AND access to all of the following via our private Band Ap Group (emailed later)
 - digital videos and photos from both shows
 - digital group photos from class
 - digital behind the scenes photos and videos from rehearsals and recital
 - digital show programs

NOTE: NOT INCLUDED in this fee are any recital tickets, tshirts, printed photos, flash drives of the video, printed programs and keepsake/gifts. All of those items can be purchased individually for separate fees..





NEW CMI Save & Spend Program!

We are aware of the rising cost of EVERYTHING, including dancewear, shoes, and costumes and do not want the cost of a shoe to be a detourrant for a family to not join a class.


This is why we have created the CMI Save & Spend Program which will allow you to turn in gently used leotards, unitards and most styles of dance shoes to receive a gift certificate good towards purchasing your next pair of shoes or dancewear item in our store.

HOW IT WORKS?

- Simply collect any gently used leotard, unitard, or pair of dance shoes your student has outgrown
- Clean the items the best you can
- Put the items in a bag and include a piece of paper inside with your FIRST and LAST NAME, and CELL PHONE NUMBER included
- Drop off the bag of items with your contact info inside at our FRONT DESK anytime during our normal operating hours
- EVERY TWO WEEKS our owner, Amanda, will gather all items dropped off, inspect them and assign them a value.
- Next you will receive a text with a \$\$\$ offer for CMI to take your gently used items in exchange for a CMI Boutique gift certificate worth the offered \$\$.

Use your Gift Certificate to purchase new dancewear and shoes in our boutique for up to 12 months after it is issued - so plenty of time for your student to grow and need the next size up - of everything!

Fundraising Opportunities

All fundraising will be sales organized and offered through the studio where a percentage of each item sold will be credited towards the child's account whom sold them. (No refunds or cash value for any funds earned.)

We will offer TWO fundraising opportunities in the 2025-2026 season for any student to participate in. Please Note - these are NOT required but instead are just another way CMI tries to help our families offset the costs of allowing their children to participate in our programs. We truly hope these help!

Fundraiser #1 - In 2024-2025 season - Fun Pasta Fundraising (completely online and shipped direct to the purchaser - so nothing to handle!) This past year was another **BIG SUCCESS** - as we sold over \$3000 and our students earned over \$1000

Fundraiser #2 - 2024-2025 Kellis Kettlecorn - Selling JAN thru FEB - was another huge success with over \$3000 in popcorn sold again this year and our top sellers earning boutique gift certificates up to \$75 in addition to earning 40% of their sales applied to their accounts!



Parent Watch Weeks

At CMI, we do not allow parents inside the classrooms during class time, as it can be distracting for both the students and our staff. We believe that minimizing these distractions helps our dancers stay focused and get the most out of each lesson.

To ensure every student receives personalized attention, we intentionally keep our class sizes smaller than most studios. However, we also understand how important it is for parents to stay connected and see their child's progress throughout the season.


That's why we've installed cameras in all of our dance rooms. These serve not only as a safety and security measure—allowing our owner to review class footage as needed—but also as a way for families to observe classes through a **LIVE STREAM** displayed on our lounge TV.

To keep things fair and to make space for other studio features throughout the year, we've created a Parent Watch Week schedule. This schedule is posted on our seasonal calendar so you can plan ahead to “tune in” during your child's scheduled time.

Here's how it works:

Each week, we feature one dance room on the lounge TV. For example, if your child takes Acro in the Blue Room, you'll want to check the calendar to find the week when the Blue Room is featured. During that week, simply stop by during your child's class and enjoy watching them in action from the comfort of our lounge.

During the first half of our season, our focus is on building strong technique in each dance style. After the holiday break, we begin working on recital choreography (in most classes), so you'll be able to enjoy seeing both skill development and performance preparation over the course of the year.



Student Awards & Celebrations

Going for Gold

Gold tickets are given out by each instructor at random during class(es).

These tickets are awarded to students who display outstanding achievements in their class. The purpose of Going for Gold is to encourage students to practice outside of class and work on improving their skills, as well as encourage them to be good classmates and students in class.

These achievements are not limited to dance, tumbling and singing - but can also be awarded based on determination, teamwork, listening skills, compassion, etc.

Students can also earn Gold Tickets by practicing their class skills and choreography outside of class, recording themselves, and then **posting that video to their class Band Group.**

There will be a drawing from our bucket of Golden Tickets 2-3 times per year, in which the students drawn will receive a CMI Boutique gift certificate to spend in the store.



Student Awards & Celebrations

CMI Spirit Award

The CMI Spirit Award will be given Annually

This award is not based on skill or talent but instead the amount of effort, compassion and support that a student exemplifies while engaging in any activities within the CMI studio.

A nominee will be selected from each instructor and given to our owner, Amanda, whom will make the final decision as to who will receive the award.
(Sept thru April)

The winner will be announced and a gift will be awarded to the recipient(s) at the end of the annual Recital during our awards ceremony.

Only those students who attend the 8 month season and perform in the annual recital are eligible to receive this award.

Technique-only classes do not participate in the recital. These classes focus on skill development, do not include choreography, and therefore do not have a costume or costume fee.

Our preschool classes will perform in a special Pre-Show just before the main recital begins. These youngest performers will take the stage early and are not required to stay for the full recital — but they still get the full performance experience, complete with costumes, lights, and the excitement of friends and family cheering them on!

NOTE: ALL tuition and monthly fees due must be paid IN FULL by the APRIL 1st in order to be eligible to receive your Recital and/or Showcase Costumes, Accessories, etc AND to be able to purchase tickets, recital tshirts and more during our Fall Season

A RECITAL INFO PACKET will be provided to all families in early March, which will outline all of the details you will want to know to be prepared for the Photo Day, Studio Rehearsal, Dress Rehearsal and Recital. We always do our best to ensure our families are fully informed as far in advance as possible so we can all have an enjoyable ending to our dance and performing arts season!
